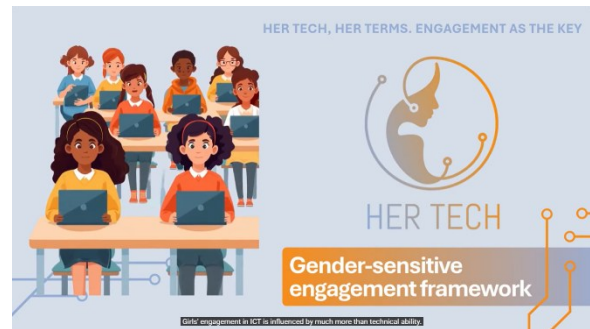
Gender-Sensitive Engagement Framework

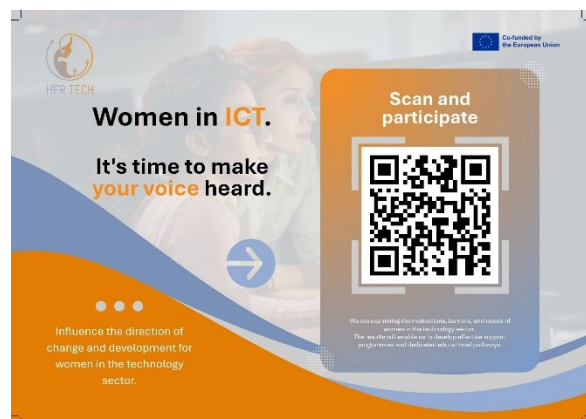
